**Maxim's Art Nouveau "Collection 1900"**, also known as the **Musée Art Nouveau-Maxim's**, is a private collection of Art Nouveau objects and decor. Pierre Cardin, the owner of Maxim's restaurant (a symbol for Art Nouveau) since 1981, has collected objects from the Belle Epoque for over 60 years. There are more than 550 pieces from all over the world, signed by Louis Majorelle, Louis Comfort, Tiffany, Émile Gallé, Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec and Clement Massier. These objects are displayed in a 12-room apartment building (three floors) which is now classified as an historic monument. Highlights of the collection include furniture by Majorelle, a sofa inspired by Antoni Gaudí and recreations of bedrooms from that time period.
